



How to learn English quickly

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How to effectively learn English with or without a teacher, in a limited time?

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Receptive and productive skills.

What exactly do you mean when you say "I want to learn English quickly"? What skills are included in the concept of "learn"? Here are the main ones:

- Speaking
- Listening
- Reading
- Writing

When we speak or write, we are active, we create a unique, our own speech product. Speaking and writing are productive skills.

When we read or listen, we perceive what other people say or write, we ourselves are silent. Reading and listening are receptive skills (from the word receive — to receive, to perceive).

Speaking

Everyday practice

1. Talk to a Russian-speaking teacher;
2. Talk to a native speaker;
3. Talk to other English learners;
4. When none of the above is around, it's all the same to speak aloud in English.

1. The advantages of studying with a Russian-speaking teacher, especially at the initial stage, are obvious: you feel "safe". Even if you don't switch to Russian unnecessarily, there is always an awareness that, if anything, you will always be understood. This can be compared to how kids learn to swim on an inflatable mattress or a ball — they work with their hands and feet a little, but then they relax, and the mattress still keeps on the water. For beginners, this may be good, but how to learn English quickly with this approach? If you are not lucky with a teacher, the training can take many years. Although, if the teacher is competent, and the student is ready to work actively and "stay on the water" even with a safety net, then you can learn English quickly in this way.

2. Classes with native speakers are usually more expensive, but it's worth it: the student is "thrown into the water", the most real communication situation. If you lose the thread or forget the word in such a situation, there is nothing left but to reformulate your thought, pick up a synonym, show on your fingers, in the end. Speaking, usually takes up most of the lesson with a native speaker. Such conversations form the strongest neural connections in the brain. Therefore, this is one of the optimal ways to easily learn English at a conversational level, especially if you already have some kind of base. However, if it is not there, then it can be difficult with the carrier. The fact is that some native speakers (people from the USA, Canada, Great Britain, Australia and some other countries), although they teach the language, have not received special training and you will not hear explanations of certain linguistic phenomena from them. While Russian qualified teachers have these explanations bouncing off their teeth. Fortunately, the tendency to hire teachers without education, on the principle of "if only there was a carrier" is gradually coming to naught.

3. Speaking English with fellow students is a well-proven auxiliary way to quickly learn English. Why is it auxiliary? Because it is most often used when teaching in a group, where an experienced teacher guides students, helps them communicate, while paying attention to the use of the material covered. That is, the students are under control, but the field of activity can be very wide. This option allows you to play games, compete, argue with opponents, discuss different ideas and face reactions to them in real time. It turns out a good imitation of real communication, again, in safe mode.

4. When there is no one at hand, and you want to talk in English, you can also talk alone with yourself, organizing classes in a special way. There are many ways to quickly learn English on your own, but they all require self-motivation, discipline and regularity. Like in the gym — no one expects to get results by exercising once every two weeks? So, instructions for English learners on a desert island (it is highly desirable that Internet access is organized on the island):

If you are watching a movie or a Youtube channel and hear a noteworthy English phrase, click "stop". Choose only interesting phrases, with an interesting intonation, an unusual word. This way there are more chances that you will have an emotional response, a necessary condition for learning English easily and simply.

Writing

To understand how to learn English quickly and improve your writing skills in English, you need to decide on goals. Why do you need written English? Is your work related to communicating with foreign colleagues by email or writing advertising texts on social networks, or do you need to know how to write a letter to the support service of some site? That's where you direct your efforts. The exercises should meet your needs, although writing an essay on a free topic is also an exciting activity for many. Here are some examples of real-life writing assignments that can be completed:

- Write a real letter to someone, wait for an answer, reply, etc.;

- Keep your own blog in English;
- Write comments on English-language websites;
- Fill out the questionnaires and registration forms.

In recent decades, the way of writing texts has changed very dramatically. Messengers, social networks, the ability to comment on videos, new communication styles have appeared. Some abbreviations and slang can be learned only by corresponding with foreigners on the Internet. This is not a way to learn English perfectly, but it will teach you a modern written language.

Listening

Now, if I knew all the grammar and all the words, I would understand everything! — some people think and are deeply mistaken. An obstacle may be too fast speech, the inability to isolate the main semantic blocks, the inability to determine by ear where one word ends and another begins.

In fact, understanding every word is not a prerequisite for successful listening. A more useful skill would be to isolate the essence of the message. Also, if the message contains important numbers, addresses, names, they also need to be isolated from the speech stream.

Often in textbooks there is an audio application with dialogues. But how much will listening to such recordings help to hear the interlocutor in life and how can you quickly learn English while trying to understand such dialogues? In real life, we do not hear a dialogue between two people from the outside, but participate in it. We hear the interlocutor and have the opportunity to answer, clarify what we did not understand, and also, most often, there is an opportunity to observe the facial expressions and gestures of the speaker, which facilitates the process of understanding. Therefore, a communicative approach to listening, when the listening skill is integrated into a natural communication situation, seems preferable.

You can also practice listening skills with teachers or just people who are ready to speak English with you. Everything that is listed in the paragraph about speaking works here. It's just that if you want to learn English quickly, you need to practice active listening and speaking more often, sometimes diluting them with passive watching movies in English or listening to songs, radio shows and podcasts.

Reading

Problems faced by many who try to read in English:

- There are too many unfamiliar words, so you have to constantly stop and look into the dictionary;
- All the words seem familiar, but it is impossible to understand the meaning of the sentence;
- Reading progresses very slowly and the thread of the plot is lost, it becomes uninteresting.

Writing out and memorizing each new word can and will help improve your English, as we have already written how to learn new words quickly. But it is unlikely to help you improve the skill of actually reading. When reading in Russian, we can easily miss an incomprehensible word, the plot captures and we move on. Try to practice the same approach in English, discarding perfectionism. Read the book "for speed", having allocated yourself a week or two. If you do not have time — skip unfamiliar words, follow the development of the plot.

Two techniques of "inattentive" reading that will help you read in English as in your native language:

- Reading "diagonally". Do you remember the lectures at the institute? Read the text quickly in search of a general idea, as if you don't have time. Ask yourself simple questions: what is this text about? Where is the action taking place? Who writes? Do not delve into the intricacies of the plot and lexical means.
- Scanning. Run your eyes through the text and find some specific information you need: phone number, date, fact. Posters, guidebooks and similar information sources are often viewed this way.

All four skills work together, and when you train one of them, you prepare the ground for the other. Make English a part of your life. Learn to switch from speaking to listening, from listening to reading, and so on. Very quickly you will speak, understand, write and read much better.

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
