The ability - to get an explanation is the ability to explain events and goals to students in different situations in a clear and understandable way, to explain the problem to them in a clear and understandable way, and to arouse active interest in students independently.

The ability to observe - the ability to enter the inner world of the student is a psychological observation related to the ability to understand the personality of the student and his temporary mental states very well. A competent tutor can perceive even the smallest changes in the internal state of students based on minor external appearances.

Speech ability - is the ability to clearly and clearly express one's thoughts and feelings in the form of speech, as well as by means of gestures. This is very important for the tutoring profession. The tutor's

speech is always aimed at educational goals. A tutor's speech should always have its own inner strength, confidence, and the character of inviting students to what he is talking about.

Communicative ability - is a psychological characteristic that allows the tutor to correctly express his thoughts, feelings, and emotions in relations with students, to be sincerely accepted by the interlocutor, and to successfully defend his views during the interview process.

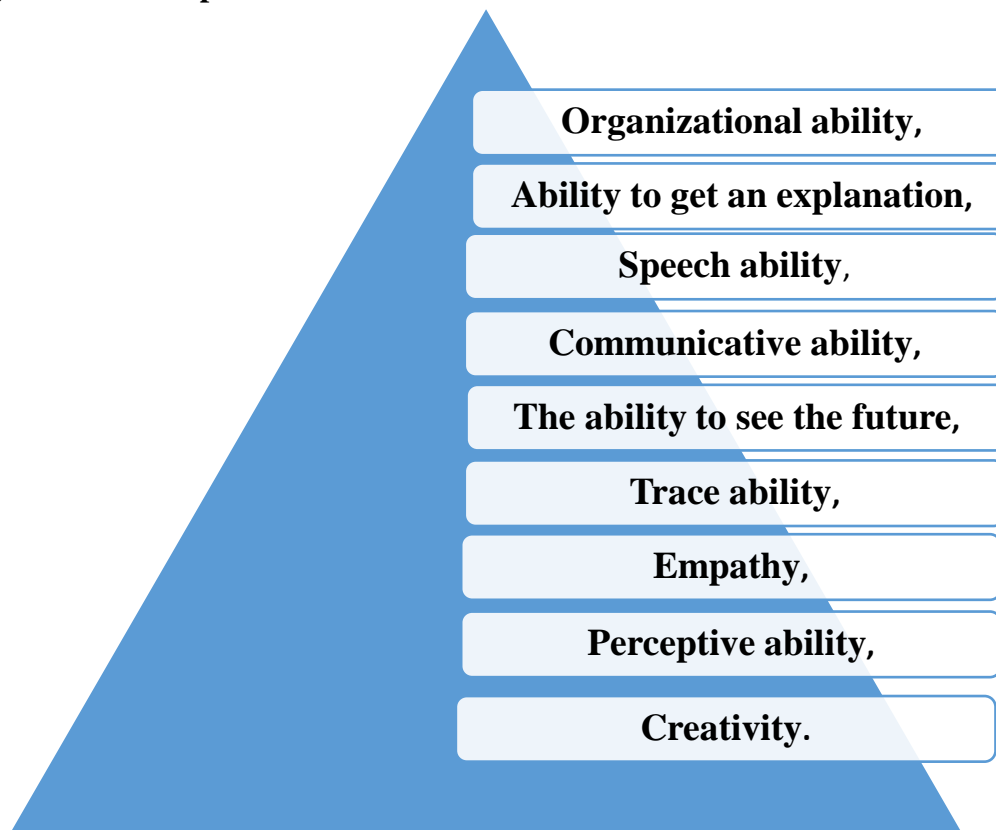
The ability to see the future - is a special ability that is expressed in foreseeing the consequences of one's actions, predicting the future behavior of students, results and consequences, and the development of certain qualities of the student. This ability is related to optimism, the power of education, and belief in people.

Empathy - is the ability to understand and sympathize with the mental states of other people. shows qualities.

Perceptive ability - sensing, perception of the external world and the environment, i.e. observation plays an important role. It develops and improves as a result of the enthusiasm of the teacher. The teacher perceives the psychology and mental state of the student by himself, makes a fair assessment of the situation of the class team and the pedagogical situation.

Creativity ability - to be able to show examples of creativity in organizing various events and educational evenings, skillfully organize events based on surprising ideas .

A skilled tutor can determine the factors of development of his abilities according to the following:

1) Constant reading of books, in which the need to read scientific and literary examples with special attention is emphasized. This tutor's personal worldview, eloquence, communication patterns, emergence of science and worldview, presentability, ability to argue, and knowledge are formed.

2) To observe and analyze the process of work and creativity of tutors who have achieved success in their activities, to apply them to their own personality based on their own characteristics. In this process, it is important to pay attention to the tutor's ability to communicate, influence, organize and educate the student body.

3) the tutor's productivity increases based on learning to create independently, striving to be as punctual as possible. This gives him self-confidence and pride.
